	Applicants are evaluated based on their application documents and we reserve the right to select only those candidates who meet our requirements.
	Extensions are possible only from Winter to Summer term, after making official request during exchange (usually in December) and after getting approval from all parties (sending and receiving schools). Not all extensions will be permitted as it depends on the availability of places during next semester.
